### RULES OF PLAY

**Format:** 54 Hole stroke play event. Play is governed by USGA Rules

**Divisions:** Championship - 54 and under. Senior – 55 and older. \*\*Super Senior – 65 and older.

**Out of Bounds:** As defined by the local course rules – see course rule sheets

**Scratch Rule:** If your ball lies in rocks outside of a hazard, you may lift, scratch and replace your ball as near as possible to its original position. **You're playing competitors must agree scratching is warranted before the ball is moved.**

**New Out of Bounds / Lost Ball Rule –** The committee has adopted the USGA's new local rule. If ball is lost or out of bounds, you may estimate where the ball last crossed the margin and proceed to the nearest point on the fairway – no closer to the hole. There you can drop within two club lengths **with a TWO STROKE penalty.** Playing a provisional ball is still an option but then the option to drop in the fairway is no longer available. It is the player's option to use the new rule or to hit another from the original position.

**Hazards:** Most Water Hazards are defined by red lines or red stakes. In the absence of lines or stakes the hazard shall be defined by the break in the ground. You can now ground your club in a hazard, **but you can't ground your club in a bunker.**

**Distance Measuring Devices Allowed:** Only Devices that measure distance only. In accordance with USGA Rules of Golf, Rule 14-3. Therefore, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that **measures distance only.**

**Ground Under Repair:** As defined by the local course rules on the reverse side, or any areas marked GUR , DROP or outlined in white paint.

**Electronic Devices:** The USGA no longer bans listening devices during play. However, Rule 1.2 is still in effect prohibiting a player from doing anything that might distract another player. Therefore, no LOUD music that might distract players in your foursome or any other players on the course.

**Pace of Play:** Players are expected to complete play in approximately 4 ½ hours, and should always keep pace with the group in front of them.

**Upon Completion of Play:** Sign score cards and turn into pro shop.

**\*\*Hole-by-Hole Information\*\***

- #1,2,3:** The driving range between these holes is NOT OUT OF BOUNDS
- #3:** Road to left of hole is OB
- #5:** OB left / over green in yard – white stakes define
- #6:** If ball goes in creek on either side – drop circle in center may be used
- #7:** OB left – white stakes define
- #8:** OB left – white stakes define
- #9** Wet area at bottom of fairway with the high grass is a free drop
- #10:** If tee shot enters into water – DROP circle to left front side of green
- #15:** OB left if the ball rests in the yard of home up near the green
- #16:** Bunker on left side AND right side of fairway are free drops – use nearest relief
- #18:** Wet area near cart path up near green is free drop

**\*\*TEES\*\***

Men should play from the WHITE tee markers, all players participating in the SUPER SENIOR DIVISION should play from the GOLD tee markers

**\*\*Ball may be lifted, cleaned and placed within 1 club length of its original location in your own fairway,

**\*\*Hole-by-Hole Information\*\***

- #2:** Parking lot behind green is OB.
- #3:** City Maintenance Building; left of cart path is OB. Fence left and behind green defines OB.
- #4:** Fence left of creek defines OB.
- #5:** Fence behind green defines OB.
- #6:** Fence left of fairway and behind green defines OB.
- #7:** Fence left of fairway and green defines OB.
- #9:** Fence behind green defines OB.

**\*\*Please play 2 balls if in question of a ruling\*\***

**\*\*TEES\*\***

Men should play from the RED tee markers for the first 9 and the WHITE tee markers for the back 9. All players participating in the SUPER SENIOR DIVISION should play from the YELLOW tee markers

**\*\*Hole-by-Hole Information\*\***

- #1:** White stakes at range defines OB. White stakes right of fairway define OB.
- #2:** White stakes right of cart path define OB.
- #3:** White stakes right of cart path define OB.
- #6:** White stakes left and right define OB.
- #7:** White stakes left and right define OB.
- #9:** Road right of path defines OB.
- #11:** Road behind green defines OB.
- #12:** White stakes left of green define OB.
- #13:** White stakes left of fairway define OB.
- #16:** White stakes left and right of fairway define OB.
- #18:** White stakes left of fairway, road behind green define OB.
